ABSTRAK

Latar belakang: Masa remaja diwarnai oleh pertumbuhan yang sangat cepat dan merupakan masa pencarian jati diri, dalam proses pencarian jati diri ini banyak menjerumuskan remaja pada perilaku yang berisiko. Perilaku remaja yang berisiko terhadap kesehatan reproduksi dapat mengakibatkan beberapa penyakit diantaranya penyakit kelamin, kanker serviks, HIV/AIDS juga akan berakibat pada tindakan aborsi akibat kehamilan yang tidak diinginkan.

Tujuan penelitian: Mengetahui faktor-faktor yang mempengaruhi perilaku seks remaja kelas XI di SMAN Y Banjarmasin Tahun 2015.

Metode penelitian: penelitian *survey analitik dengan cross sectional*. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah siswa dan siswi kelas XI di SMAN Y Banjarmasin tahun 2015 yang berjumlah 138 orang dan sampel sebanyak 103 orang dengan menggunakan teknik *simplerandom sampling*.

Hasil: Hasil penelitian dari 103 responden paling banyak mempunyai pengetahuan baik sebesar 75 (72,8%), sikap negatif sebesar 60 (58,3%), informasi sedikit sebesar 63 (61,2%), dan untuk perilaku seks paling banyak tidak beres sebesar 58 (56,3%) dari hasil analisis uji *spearman rank* didapatkan hasil pengetahuan didapatkan hasil p value 0,000 < 0,05 () artinya ada hubungan antara pengetahuan dengan perilaku seks. sikap didapatkan hasil p value 0,000 < 0,05 () artinya ada hubungan antara sikap dengan perilaku seks dan untuk media informasi didapatkan hasil p value 0,000 < 0,05 () artinya ada hubungan antara media informasi dengan perilaku seks.

Kesimpulan: Terdapat hubungan antara pengetahuan, sikap dan media informasi dengan perilaku seks remaja.

ABSTRACT

Intorfuction: Puberty was marked by rapid growth and was the period of seeking for identity, which in its process, there were so many things that trapped teens to risk behavior. Teenagers' behavior at risk of reproductive health might cause several diseases, for example sexually transmitted disease, cervical cancer, HIV/AIDS also might effect to abortion on unwanted pregnancy.

Objectives: Knew factors affect teenagers' sexual behavior of second grade students in SMAN Y Banjarmasin in 2015.

Methods: The method used in this study was analytical survey with cross sectional approach. Population in this study was second grade students in SMAN Y Banjarmasin in 2015 by 138 and sample was 103 students that was taken by *simplerandom sampling*.

Results: The result of this study was 103 respondents, mostly had good knowledge as much as 75 (72,8%), negative attitude was 60 (58,3%), lack of informations was 63 (61,2%), and for sexually behavior, they were mostly in not at risk behavior as much as 58 (56,3%). Based on analytical result of spearman rank test, the knowledge was in p value $0,000 < 0,05$ () which meant as there was correlation between knowledge and sexual behavior. Attitude was in p value $0,000 < 0,05$ () which meant as there was correlation between attitude and sexual behavior. And for information media was in p value $0,000 < 0,05$ () which meant there was correlation between information media and sexual behavior.

Conclusion: There was correlation among knowledge, attitude, and information media and teenagers sexual behavior.
