

Role of Relationship Between Exclusive Breastfeeding Husband With success in Kayu Tangi Working Area Health Center Banjarmasin

ABSTRACT

Background: The success of the breastfeeding process is also determined by the husband's role. Role as important as the role of husband and wife. Husband's role is to create a situation that allows breastfeeding goes smoothly. The results of the data according DINKES Banjarmasin for achieving the target of exclusive breastfeeding in 2013 was 74.24%. Based on the annual report of the health center Kayu Tangi Banjarmasin area is 67.5% that do exclusive breastfeeding and still under achievement DINKES Banjarmasin 74.24%.

Objective: This study aimed to determine the relationship of the husband's role in the success of exclusive breastfeeding.

Methods: This study used a sampling probability done by simple random sampling. The sample consisted of 84 respondents. Data was collected using a kuesioner. The data was then analyzed using the fisher's exact tes with significant value of $p < 0.05$.

Results: The results showed for the husband's role in good categories is 94%. Exclusive breastfeeding category is 34.5%. Then by using the fisher's exact tes p -value = 0.113 obtained by as $p < 0.05$.

Conclusion: There is no relationship between the husband's role in the success of exclusive breastfeeding servicing Health Center Kayu Tangi area of Banjarmasin.
